

Life keeps coming. Work stress, family pressure, disappointments that stack up, those brief wins that fade before we can even celebrate them properly. Our hearts get pulled in every direction, and most days we're just trying to keep up.

The psalmists get it. They wrote from real life—the loneliness, the anger, the exhaustion, the unexpected joy. And through all of it, they kept returning to this practice of praise. Not because it made them feel better in the moment (sometimes it didn't), but because it kept them connected to something bigger than their circumstances.

"Praise" feels like such a churchy word, doesn't it? The kind of thing that makes some of us think of raised hands and worship songs we don't quite connect with. The Psalmists weren't talking about a style of worship or a certain kind of music. They were talking about something we all desperately need: a way to stay grounded when life keeps coming at us.

So this November, I want us to explore what happens when gratitude grows into something more sustaining. What if praise isn't just something we add to our faith, but actually how faith stays alive in us?

Join us for four weeks as we walk through some psalms together and discover why this ancient practice might be exactly what we need for the lives we're actually living.
