Our Summer Serving in Brazil.

A few weeks ago, we returned home from our summer serving in Brazil. It was an incredible opportunity, and we are so grateful that we were able to go! It was very fulfilling to make a difference in such a practical way through Jeyson serving in the hangar, helping to get Asas de Socorro's planes back in the air.

One huge project took place in the city of Boa Vista, an isolated city in the Amazon. The mission has a very busy flight program in Boa Vista, with over 700 hours flown each year to villages by just one plane! And this one plane was badly in need of updating. During our time in Boa Vista, Jeyson and the rest of the maintenance team did an unbelievable amount of work in a short time. The plane's inside was stripped down, and new seats, side paneling, and ceiling were installed. The avionics system was updated with new equipment, and the whole outside of the plane was repainted.

The days were super long, HOT, and tiring for the team. Some nights, the team only returned home at 11 p.m. And once, the hangar flooded with rain while the men were trying to paint the plane. But in the end, almost all of the goals were checked off the list. On the last day, it was incredibly fulfilling for the mission's families to gather at the hangar to watch the







successful test flight. Authorized! The plane could get back to operations. Back to giving wings to the Good News of Jesus.

The major focus the rest of the summer was Jeyson working with the local missionary team to repair one of the mission's Cessna 206 airplanes. A few months ago, this plane suffered an accident in a village. Fortunately, no one was hurt, but the plane was significantly damaged. The mission has been working to overhaul and renew this plane and eventually get it back in the air flying to villages.
