Dear Pastor Adam and all our friends at Calvary Bible Church,

We greatly appreciate your generous donation! This month, we would like to update you on recent changes: we pray that the Lord will help us to lower the number of annual abortions in our country, which for 2024 stood at over a million lives lost, a 12% increase since 2020. That increase is mainly due to the availability of mail-order chemical abortion pills, which lead to more than 63% of all abortions in the United States. We thank God that the Food and Drug Administration Commissioner this month promised a full-scale investigation into the abortion pill's safety, since a study of insurance data found that nearly 11% of women who take the abortion pill experienced serious complications requiring emergency room treatment.

Therefore, there is even more need for Center services like ours: Family Research Council have been publishing updated reports on the benefits provided by centers like ours since 2009. The latest report, updated in December 2024, offers encouraging data drawn from 2,750 pregnancy centers and mobile units in all 50 states. It recorded 16 million client visits in person and virtually in 2022, providing diapers, baby clothing, new car seats, and baby furniture. An increasing number of centers like ours continue to provide training in Biblical marriage and parenting skills for parents of infants through teen years.

Since 40% of babies in this country are born to unmarried mothers, we have a continuing responsibility to take every opportunity to train our young people in the Success Sequence: the poverty- preventing impact of taking three positive steps in the proper order: graduating from high school, getting a full -time job, or marrying a man with a full-time job, and getting married before having children. Young people who observe all three measures have a 97% chance of avoiding poverty as they move into adulthood and are significantly less likely to experience a family breakdown and emotional distress as adults. By some measures, maintaining a full -time job alone accounts for nearly all the Sequence's poverty reduction. We encourage attendance at the One Stop Career Center or provide localized job website information as needed to client families, together with offering regular bilingual budgeting classes by Dave Ramsay. We treasure your kindness and concern for the fatherless families we serve, and we pray God will fill your life with His blessings!
