## **Proclaiming Christ in Every Place: Outreach Highlights from February and March (March 1, 2026)**

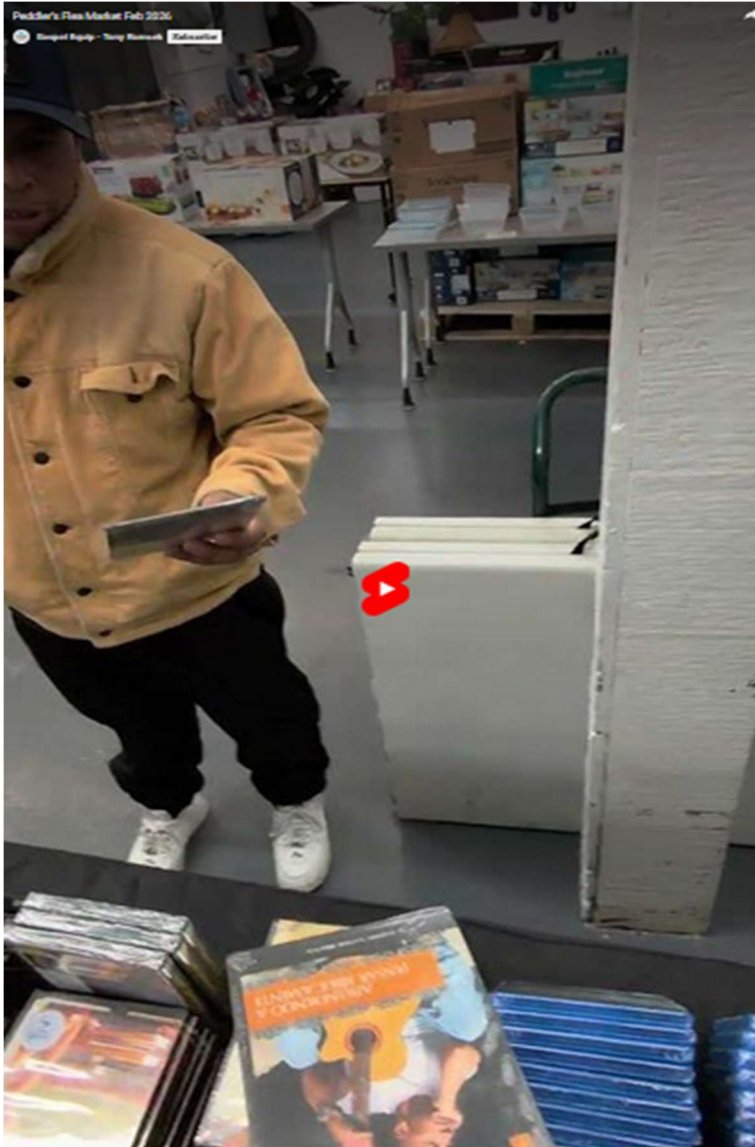

#### **Peddler's Flea Market — February 7**

As we spoke with both vendors and visitors, we were encouraged by Paul's words: "We are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us" (2 Corinthians 5:20).

Just days later, the Lord provided another opportunity in Cincinnati. Conversations ranged from questions about assurance to prayer for personal struggles. We were reminded that the gospel

is not just truth to proclaim — it is hope to offer. By God’s grace we were able to give out over 1000 Christian DVD’s for free. Some of them featured Bible teachers like Dr. John MacArthur and Ken Ham. We held a Witnessing Workshop in our home church, Torch Community Church. I love these Workshops because they are filled with us rehearsing the gospel in the classroom. Even the pastor said that it’s always inspiring to hear the glorious gospel preached at these evangelism training sessions.

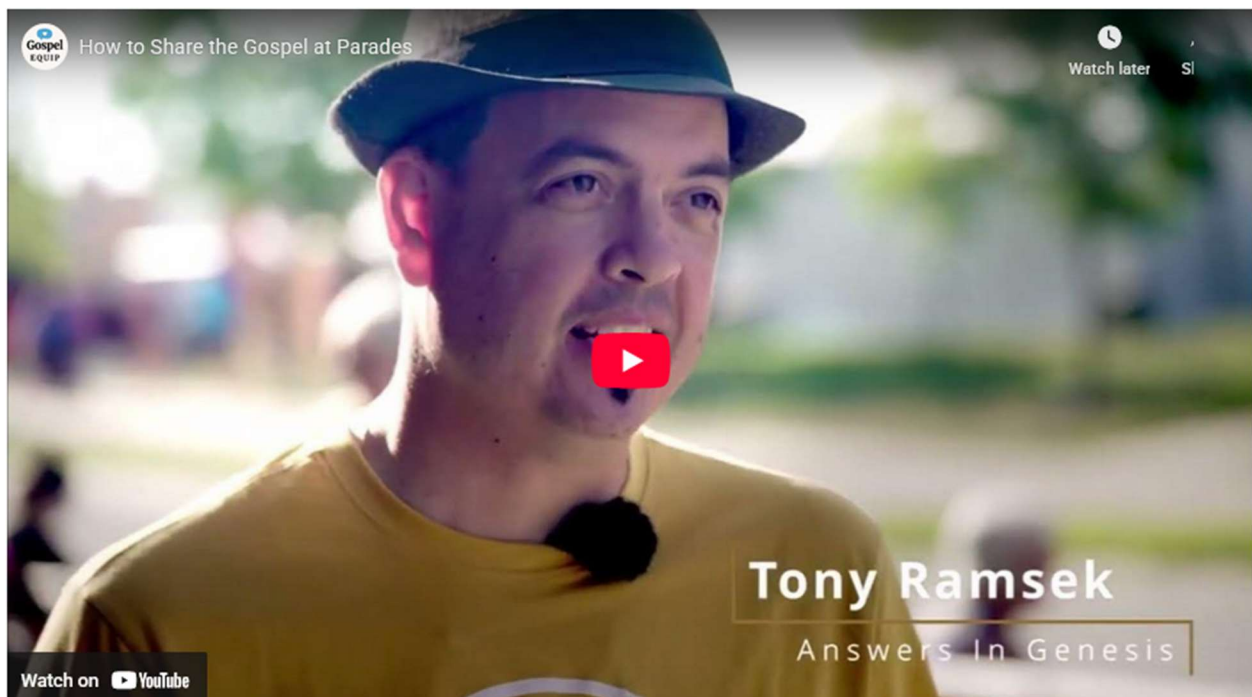
## Looking Ahead: March Opportunities

The Garden Tomb offers a peaceful setting where visitors stand before an empty tomb that powerfully testifies to the living Savior.



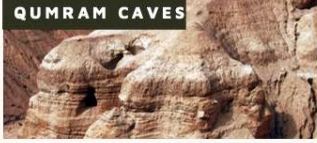
### SEA OF GALILEE

### EASTERN GATE



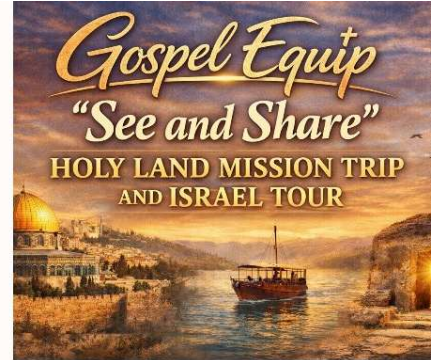
The Eastern Gate overlooks the Kidron Valley where Scripture points to the Messiah's future triumphant return to Jerusalem.



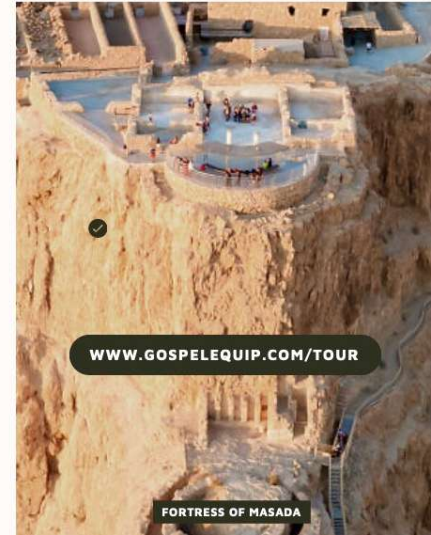
### CAPERNAUM
