Used cars have become very expensive and no one in our friend circles has had one for us to use for our travels. A previous option was to use a car that couldn't make the journey without extensive and costly repairs. But when the search for another car failed, the only option remaining was to repair the car. The car was shipped to us from Florida and we got it to a mechanic to estimate the total cost for repairs. God used Christan Brothers Automotive to repair the car and we have been using it since August without trouble. We are grateful to the Lord and to our son's wife Nathasha and mother Lori for providing the car and to Christian Brothers Automotive who did all the work to restore the 2007 Pontiac Torrent at no cost to us. Travel is going well, and our family is well too.
