## Dear faithful prayer partners and financial supporters

Greetings in the precious name of our Lord and Savior. Jesus Christ

The month of December was pretty much challenging health-wise, especially during the second half of the month. Each one of us took turns to become sick. Prior to that, we celebrated the first wedding at Eglise Baptist Biblique Salem of Tamanyi. As it is custom to celebrate the wedding in the girl's church when the groom is from another church, it was a great time of rejoicing and a good example for the teens of the churches to witness this great milestone of life.

Our 8-passenger minivan, which we acquired in 2024, ran well for about a year before some major problems started. Since the month of October, it has not yet been repaired. First, timing chains were replaced, and then some repairs were also performed on the transmission. This upsets Samuel because the van has become his favorite car. Therefore, he is asking that we repair it immediately. Despite all the effort of the mechanics at two different shops, it still cannot be repaired. Some advised that it might need reprogramming.

Elisabeth (my wife) became sick during the last week of December. We spent three days at the clinic for care. On Wednesday, December 31st, the treatment was over, but as she was still weak, we didn't go to church to welcome the new year but stayed home.

Koffi finished preaching a sermon series on the epistle to the Ephesians on Sunday morning. On Wednesday evenings, he completed the study on revelation using materials from the regular Baptist press (the revelation of Jesus-Christ.)

On January 31, we mourn the passing of a dear brother in Christ who passed away after being sick for a while. He was the homekeeper and the guardian of the church property. This brother was persecuted in his village for his faith in Christ. But during the memorial service at the church of Tamanyi, 20 members of his family came as we shared his life story. The gospel was preached, and I can hear some members of his family murmuring the sinner's prayer.

Dear brothers and sisters, As we have let you know, we are approaching the time to come to the state because of Samuel's health. Therefore, we will be in the US later in March.
