TODAY'S PREACHER



Rev. Dr. Alexis Tardy is a native of Grand Rapids, Michigan and currently resides in Indianapolis, Indiana with her partner, Joe; newborn son, Nasir Jelani; and little Yorkie, KoKo. Alexis' calling to ministry began among the community and streets of Ferguson, Missouri in the fight for justice in the murder of Michael Brown, Jr. It was in the praying with her feet that she felt the closest to Jesus and found no light between the Gospel of Jesus and justice. This led to her attending Eden Theological Seminary in St. Louis, Missouri where she earned a Master of Divinity degree as well as a Doctorate of Ministry in Womanist Preaching from Memphis Theological Seminary. In 2024, Alexis was ordained Alliance of Baptists and she currently serves as the Alliance Congregational Relations and Organizing Manager. She believes we can all draw courage to bring wholeness and healing in the face of injustice through Jesus' promise to all His disciples: "I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world."
