Again, I encourage you to use at least a couple minutes of your time to connect your class to the speaker, God, or living life for Jesus.

Example: Monday - 10 minutes: intro self and get to know kids. 10 minutes: stretching (sports). 10 minutes: passing drills, etc.

Or Monday—Tie dyeing and Hat day: 20 minutes tie dyeing and 20 minutes making hats etc. **Please attach plans on separate sheet if you need more room.**
