

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. *What do we do now?*

- Once you have contacted the office, you will have an initial meeting with the available pastor to discuss Richview's values and beliefs. The pastor will confirm if they are able to perform the ceremony after they have met with you.
- Next step would be to complete the Enrich Inventory. This online couple questionnaire assesses your couple strengths and growth areas. A report will be provided to your pastor. Together, you will review the report and develop a strategy to build on your strengths and to mature in your growth areas. 2. *Do I need to be a member of the church to be married at Richview?*

- No, you do not need to be a member. However, we are usually limited to marrying couples who are a part of our church community (i.e., regularly attending Richview, or attending and serving in a ministry area or plugged into a Community Group).

3. *Can we use Richview's facility?*

5. *Do I give the pastor an honorarium?*

- Yes, because weddings involve additional duties for the pastor including pre-marital counselling, ceremony preparation, and wedding rehearsal (as well as the wedding itself). This cheque should be made out directly to the pastor performing the ceremony.
