ASSESS

- Discuss passions and areas of interest within the group, determine what are your groups gifts and interests
- Assess your collective skills and capabilities with your group. Have an honest assessment with one another about what you can and can't do
- Review the list of ideas at www.rockbrook.org/serve and determine if any of them are a good fit
- Determine what resources your project will require and what resources your group has access to
- Assess the safety of any potential projects
- Familiarize yourself and your group with the individual or organization you are serving
- Decide together on a Serve project that is a match with the above and reach out to them

PLAN

- Register your project at www.rockbrook.org/serve
- Make a list of preparations that need to be done and resources you need to acquire prior to Serve Day
- Assign responsibilities according to each group members skills and gifts
- Determine if you have capacity for others to help your group on SERVE Day if so indicate that when you register your project at www.rockbrook.org/serve
- Communicate project flow and expectation to your group
