Where: University of Pittsburgh, Johnstown, PA

Departure: Drop off at Christ Community BEFORE 8:30am

Arrival: Leave Apex at 8:30am. Return to C3 around 4:30

Cost: \$175.00 per student. \$100 deposit due by April 14th
Cost will be raised to \$195.00 After April 15

Registration: All students must pre-register using the attached form. A non-refundable deposit of \$100 must accompany each camper registration by April 14. Total amount must be paid by May 19. Total amount may accompany this registration.

Spending Money: Students will need to bring extra spending money while at Apex. Meals to and from the event are not included. Students may also want money for offering, snack bar, book store, or T-shirts.

Emergency: Parents may call Pastor Greg at (586) 899-3791. Under normal circumstances, students should not be visited or contacted by phone while at Apex. Outgoing calling will be available to notify parents or in Emergency.

Dress Code: Daytime wear for all students is casual. Appropriate footwear (tennis shoes, sandals) must be worn. No speedos for guys. Girl's suits must be one piece or "Tankini" style. No Bikinis

Rules and Regulations:

- No guys in girls rooms or girls in guys rooms,
- No drugs, alcohol, or cigarettes
- You break it, you buy it
- Be on time and no students should be in dorms during schedules activities or services
- No one is allowed out of their dorm after curfew
- No calls from dorm room phones
- If you loose your room key, you will be charged \$75

Specific rules will be given before leaving for Apex. Each student must understand that lack of cooperation, unnecessary roughness, lack of respect for property, or an unwholesome attitude on the part of any student will result in expulsion from Apex. Expense of transporting expelled campers must be borne by the parents. There is no refund for early departures.

What to Bring: Bible, pen or pencil, notebook, towels, washcloth, soap, comb, toothbrush/toothpaste, casual clothes, swim suit (girls- modest one piece, or tankini; guys-boxer type.) In keeping with Christian standards we will not permit immodest or abbreviated attire among either guys or girls.

Students May Want To Bring: Musical instruments, camera (Video/Picture), sporting equipment, snacks. (No Skateboards or Roller Blades) Pillows and bedding are provided. Students can bring their own pillow if they want.

Electronic and Cell Phone Policy: Students will be allowed their cell phones and electronic devices for the car ride. Electronics are not to be used during the scheduled Apex activities. Students should be respectful and responsible with their electronics. Any use of electronics at an inappropriate time or use of electronics that invades another persons privacy or well being while at Apex will result in confiscation for the weekend. Apex and Christ Community Church are not responsible for lost or stolen items while on this trip.
