




*The images here are renderings of what the inside of the worship center may look like after renovations. Notice the larger stage area, two level audio / visual booth and raised seating in the rear.

In June of 1834, the church was formed as a mission church in Highland Springs, and was composed mainly of members from First Baptist Church of Richmond.




1990

Opportunities For Giving

We're asking that commitments to this campaign be above and beyond your regular giving to the church.

Whether it's a one-time gift or a commitment made over a three year span (2025-2027), we hope that each person is able to fully engage with God and the church about their own involvement in the campaign. As the giving model (right) illustrates, every level of participation is necessary for reaching our goal.

INCOME-STREAM GIVING: Giving as you receive income-from your regular income, bonuses, and/or through your personal business.

SACRIFICE: Changing your lifestyle and priorities can create additional resources for giving.

DELAYING EXPENDITURES: Postponing anticipated purchases can free resources for giving.

FREEDOM FROM DEBT: After a debt is retired, the resources that were applied to that debt are now available for giving.

GIVING ASSETS: If an investment-like stocks and other assets- has increased in value since its purchase and has been held for more than one year, then there may be tax advantages to transferring ownership of that asset to the church as a charitable donation. Giving the appreciated asset may eliminate potential capital gains taxes for the donor while still allowing the donor to receive the contribution credit for the current market value of the asset. Because of its tax-exempt status, New Bridge can sell the asset and receive full market value less transaction costs.

The fundraising goal meets the gap between what we have raised to-date, and what we will need to complete the project.

Donations Received: \$1.8 M

Remaining Goal: \$2.7 M

Total Need: \$4.5 Million

When will construction begin?

- When we reach \$2.5M in donations received, we will be in position to work with the bank and begin construction.
- The church will be working with a lender to fund the difference between total costs and funds collected. As additional funds are donated, the amount of the loan need will continue to decrease.

The plan is to have \$2.5 Million in our Building Fund, before we start construction. This money, along with a commitment from the bank for \$2 Million, will ensure there are sufficient funds available to complete the project, without delays. The desire is to continue raising money once construction starts, to minimize or eliminate the need to access the loan. While the commitment from the bank allows us to continue building without costly interruption, our ultimate goal is to raise the full need, and emerge from this expansion without long-term debt.

For us, this 29:11 Legacy fund is an opportunity to be a part of something only God can do. He is touching our hearts to give financially to make New Bridge Baptist Church bigger and better in the way we can reach people for Christ in our community and around the world. There is no higher calling than to share the love of Christ through the Gospel. We are thankful to God that we can have a small part in this.



Am I approaching this decision as if it is easy and effortless or as a challenge, requiring discipline?


How is this commitment demonstrating my expression of faith?
