**Which O.T. Laws Apply Today?**  
**Leviticus Intro & Overview (NIV)**

**Main Idea:** All the Law is fulfilled by Christ; His presence in our life helps empowers us to obey the Moral Laws.

<sup>3</sup> *You must not do as they do in Egypt, where you used to live, and you must not do as they do in the land of Canaan, where I am bringing you. Do not follow their practices.* <sup>4</sup> *You must obey my laws* and be careful to follow my decrees. *I am the LORD your God.* Leviticus 18:3-4

<sup>17</sup> *"Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them.* Matthew 5:17

- **The Law is Fulfilled in Christ**

**The 3 Types of Laws in Leviticus**

1. **Ceremonial** – pertaining to the sacrificial system and temple worship.
2. **Civil** – pertaining to Israel's Government.
3. **Moral** – timeless laws that we continue to follow.

\*Christ fulfilled Ceremonial Laws, Governments carry out and legislate Civil laws, and Moral laws such as the Ten Commandments are reinforced in the New Testament.

- **The Law Should Lead us to Christ**

<sup>24</sup> *So the law was put in charge to lead us to Christ that we might be justified by faith.* Galatians 3:24

- **The Law is Lived by the Power of Christ**

<sup>2</sup> *because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death. ... <sup>4</sup>in order that the righteous requirements of the law might be fully met in us, who do not live according to the sinful nature but according to the Spirit.* Romans 8:4

<sup>37</sup> *Love the Lord...* <sup>39</sup> *Love your neighbor...* <sup>40</sup> *All the Law* and the Prophets hang on these two commandments." Matthew 22:37-40
