**Holy, Holy, Holy**  
**Leviticus 19 (NIV)**

**Main Idea:** God is Holy and calls His people to be Holy or Set Apart.

*'Be holy because I, the Lord your God, am holy. Leviticus 19:2*

<sup>15</sup> *But just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; <sup>16</sup> for it is written: "Be holy, because I am holy."*  
1 Peter 1:15-16

**"Holy"** (Hebrew: *qādôsh*) - "pure" and "devoted. (Greek: *hagiazō*) denotes "to set apart to God" *Vine's Expository Dictionary of Old Testament and New Testament Words*

- **Christ's blood makes us holy**

<sup>11</sup> *The high priest carries the blood of animals into the Most Holy Place as a sin offering, but the bodies are burned outside the camp. <sup>12</sup> And so Jesus also suffered outside the city gate to **make the people holy through his own blood.*** Hebrews 13:11-12

- **We are guided by the Holy Spirit**

<sup>26</sup> *But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you. John 14:26*

- **We are called to live holy lives**

<sup>1</sup> *Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God--this is your spiritual act of worship.* Romans 12:1

<sup>3</sup> *But among you there must not be even a hint of sexual immorality, or of any kind of impurity, or of greed, because these are improper for God's holy people.* Ephesians 5:3

<sup>7</sup> *For God did not call us to be impure, but to live a holy life.* 1 Thessalonians 4:7
