(Jesus) For just as <u>Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of the great fish</u>, so will the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth. Matthew 12:40

1. <u>Seek</u> God in despair.

- ¹Then Jonah prayed to the LORD his God from the belly of the fish, ² saying, "I called out to the LORD, out of my <u>distress</u>, and he answered me; out of the belly of Sheol I cried, and you heard my voice.
- ³ For you cast me into the deep, into the heart of the seas, and the flood surrounded me; all your waves and your billows passed over me. Jonah 2:1–3

2. Turn back to hope.

- ⁴ Then I said, 'I am driven away from your sight; yet I shall again look upon your holy temple.'
- ⁵ The waters closed in over me to take my life; the deep surrounded me; weeds were wrapped about my head ⁶ at the roots of the mountains. I went down to the land whose bars closed upon me forever; yet you brought up my life from the pit, O LORD my God. Jonah 2:4-6

3. <u>Salvation</u> through surrender.

- ⁷ When my life was fainting away, I remembered the Lord, and my prayer came to you, into your holy temple. ⁸ Those who pay regard to vain idols forsake their hope of steadfast love.
- ⁹ But I with the voice of thanksgiving will sacrifice to you; what I have vowed I will pay. <u>Salvation</u> belongs to the Lord!" ¹⁰ And the Lord spoke to the fish, and it vomited Jonah out upon the dry land. Jonah 2:7–10

How to Receive Christ:

"Dear Jesus, thank You for loving me even though I'm a sinner. I ask for your forgiveness. I believe You died for my sin and that You rose from the dead. I trust You as my Savior and follow You as Lord, from this day forward. Amen."
