1 Peter 5:1-11 (NIV)

Christ leads us, restores us and strengthens us.

### 1. Christ entrusts leaders to lead.

<sup>1</sup>To the <u>elders</u> among you, I appeal as a fellow elder and a witness of Christ's sufferings who also will share in the glory to be revealed: <sup>2</sup> Be <u>shepherds</u> of God's flock that is under your care, <u>watching over</u> them—not because you must, but because you are willing, as <u>God wants you to be</u>; not pursuing dishonest gain, but eager to serve; <sup>3</sup> not lording it over those <u>entrusted to you</u>, but being examples to the flock. <sup>4</sup> And <u>when the Chief Shepherd appears</u>, you will receive the crown of glory that will never fade away. 1 Peter 5:1-4

## 2. Christ will lift up the <u>humble</u>.

<sup>5</sup> In the same way, you who are younger, submit yourselves to your elders. All of you, <u>clothe yourselves with humility toward one another</u>, because, "God opposes the proud but shows favor to the humble." <sup>6</sup> Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand, <u>that he may lift you</u> up in due time. <sup>7</sup> Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you. 1 Peter 5:5-6

# 3. Christ will restore and make you strong.

<sup>8</sup> <u>Be alert</u> and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. <sup>9</sup> <u>Resist him, standing firm in the faith</u>, because you know that the family of believers throughout the world is undergoing the same kind of sufferings. <sup>10</sup> And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, <u>will himself restore you and make you strong</u>, <u>firm and steadfast</u>. <sup>11</sup> To him be the power for ever and ever. Amen. 1 Peter 5:8-11
