I heard a teacher once tell his students that if what he was teaching was over their heads, they needed to jump. Sometimes we read a book like Ecclesiastes and we have to jump a little bit to understand what the teacher is teaching. On the other hand, a book like James takes these hard ideas and tells us practically how to live them out.
