I hope everyone is staying safe and warm during the cold weather! January marks five months in Poland. As I look back on the last five months, I can see multiple ways the Lord has worked in my life. This month, we finished our first semester of Bible classes, and I am learning so much about the Bible. The Lord continues to stretch me as I work with people in ministry and focus on building relationships with people in Poland. Journey to Bethlehem, teaching English, and Winter Camp have been great opportunities for me to continue connecting with people in the three cities where Proem has church plants, as well as with people in larger cities like Warsaw, Gdańsk, and Kraków.

At the beginning of the month, we finished Journey to Bethlehem. Over the course of the three weekends, 12,500 people attended and heard the story of Jesus. This past week we had our first winter camp for kids. It was a great time hanging out and loving on kids! I was a group assistant for 12 to 13 year old boys. We had around 60 campers attend. There were two groups from America who came and it was great to catch up with them. I will see several of our campers for summer camp. Pray for them as they live in other areas of Poland.
