There's a Garfield comic I remember where another animal is giving Odie a hard time. Garfield steps in, scares the animal away, and basically says, "Only I get to treat Odie that way." It's funny because, underneath the humor, there's something uncomfortably familiar about it.

In June, we will finish our forgiveness series by looking at how we extend forgiveness to others. After that, we will begin a new family series called *Finding Family*. For two Sundays we will focus on family relationships, and for three Sundays we will focus on marriage.

It's interesting that we are moving from forgiveness to family, because the people we often need to forgive the most are the people closest to us. Family has a way of bringing out both our deepest love and our deepest frustrations. If we are honest, we sometimes act a little more like Garfield than we would like to admit.

Yet God calls us to something greater — to homes marked by grace, patience, forgiveness, and love. Healthy families are not perfect families; they are families willing to extend mercy to one another again and again.

Join us in June as we wrap up our conversation on forgiveness and begin exploring what it means to build strong, Christ-centered families.
