Here's where we're going together:

Riverwood

Participants will have the option to purchase Christmas gifts for two residents in need. On the service day, up to 25 people will wrap the donated Christmas gifts and head to Riverwood for an afternoon of cookie decorating, hot cocoa enjoying, game playing, Christmas carol singing, and making new best friends!

Restoration House

Families at Restoration House are courageously pursuing stability and a brighter future. Our donations will provide a family with a winter break kit to keep little hands busy and entertained during the long winter break. On the service day, up to 25 participants will organize and pack the kits and deliver, pray over, and meet a representative to learn more about Restoration House.

Isaiah 117 House

Isaiah 117 House cares for children entering foster care—children who desperately need comfort, dignity, and safety. By supporting their needs and blessing their staff, we will help share the tender love of Christ with some of the most vulnerable among us. Donations will go to create a travel busy bag for kids being transferred to places that require a longer travel time. On the day of service, up to 20 participants will pack and pray over the bags. Then, this group will head to Isaiah 117 house for a tour and to pray over the spaces. If children are present, the group will just pray over the accessible parts of the home and for the staff. 

Charles Duhigg in his book, The Power of a Habit, tells the story of how Febreze almost flopped and then how it succeeded. At first the way Proctor and Gamble advertised the spray was that it covered up odors. The advertising was how it covered up smoke smell and also dog smells. The problem was that no one thought they needed it because they were "nose blind." They didn't know they needed the product.

Eventually they landed on an advertising strategy that worked with the product. Instead of telling people they smelled, they ran commercials of a person cleaning their house and after they had finished they did one last thing, they sprayed Febreze. It was not the product that you needed to cover up your bad smells, it was the product that you needed to signal you were done with your cleaning. It became the reward at the end of the cleaning process.

Within a month of that commercial product sales doubled and within a year they were selling \$230 million of the

It is interesting, when it was changed from a product that covers up smells to a product that was a reward it changed how people purchased it.

All year long we have looked at the idea of Living Life to the Full. In November we finish this year long series by looking at prayer, specifically the Lord's Prayer in Matthew 6. We purposefully saved this to the end. We wanted to reframe prayer as not something you do just to pray over a prayer list or just to tell God what you want, but something that has a reward of a closer relationship with God. We want prayer to be something that leads to peace and comfort. The only way that will happen is if we understand prayer the way Jesus taught it. Join us as we look through Matthew 6 with a series we have entitled, A Long Obedience in the Same Direction. The title comes from a book by Eugene Peterson and I love the idea that in prayer we enter into obedience towards God. Yet even more than this long obedience, we find life to the full.
