

What is true in families is also true in the church. Last month we had our Preview and Pie night. It is a night where we reconnect as a church and discuss where we are as a church family. We also discuss small groups and service opportunities where we can connect in the future as well. If you weren't able to be there. Let me review very briefly so you can reconnect with us.

At the event we started by discussing things we have accomplished in 2025. We mentioned things for our building and grounds like sound panels, foyer refresh and parking lot fixes. We also discussed things within the church such as interns, VBS, Camps, Prom of the Stars, Food Pantry, Sr. Meals, Newborns in Need, Sower Sewing Ministry and prayer ministry.

We discussed church finances through July: General Fund - \$238,858.91, Missions - \$70,732.25, Cash Reserve - \$10,282.54, Building - \$224,237.00. General Fund Giving is at 101% of Budget, General Fund Spending is at 102% of Budget.

And we discussed our attendance through July: Year average - 311, Sanctuary - 249, Kids - 60.

We also looked at opportunities to connect going forward. We mentioned all of our small groups (Sunday evening, Wednesday afternoon and evening, men's groups, women's groups, and Sunday school). We also discussed a big Christmas project that will be coming up the second Sunday of December.

Connection is a good thing, it helps us stay healthy as a church. We hope you will connect or reconnect with us this fall!
