How do you know when you are full? There are some people who stop eating before they are full, others do a good job of knowing when they are full, and still others who just keep eating and are miserable because they didn't know that they were full.

All year long we have been talking about living life to the full, but what does it mean to be full? What does it look like when we are full? It is important for us to figure out what it looks like for a Christian to be full of Christ's love and spirit. It is important for us to live it out. If we stop before we are full, we might fill the leftover longing with junk food. If we can't tell when we are full, we might overindulge and not give away the good food to people who need it.

In September, after we finish the book of James we are going to camp out for seven weeks in Romans 8. We will slowly move through a chapter where we can see what it looks like to be full. A chapter that will end with these two glorious verses, "For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord."
