

Wise Financial Strategy For Charitable Giving

Net Income/(Loss)

For many retirees, charitable giving to Calvary Baptist is meaningful, and giving from retirement funds can also be a smart financial strategy. By donating directly from your retirement account, specifically a traditional IRA, you can support Calvary and potentially lower your tax bill. This type of contribution is called a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD).

What is a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD)?

A QCD is a direct transfer of funds from your traditional IRA to a qualified charity, such as a church. This distribution does not count as taxable income, even though it comes from a pre-tax retirement account.

The key rules are:

- You must be 70 ½ years old or older at the time of the donation.
- The donation must be made directly from the IRA custodian to the church (only applies to traditional IRAs, but 401(k)s or 403(b)s can be rolled over to a traditional IRA).
- You can donate up to \$100,000 per year (per individual) or \$200,000 for married couples filing jointly (with each spouse having their own IRA).
- The donation must be completed by December 31 of the tax year to count.

How It Saves on Taxes

Normally, when you withdraw funds from a traditional IRA, the full amount is added to your adjusted gross income (AGI) and taxed as ordinary income, but a QCD:

- Avoids taxable income: The amount given directly to a church via a QCD is excluded from your AGI.
- Reduces required minimum distributions (RMDs): After age 73, you're required to take RMDs from your IRA. QCDs can satisfy all or part of your RMD, reducing your taxable income.
- Helps avoid itemizing: Because QCDs reduce your taxable income directly, you get a tax benefit even if you don't itemize deductions (which many retirees don't, due to the higher standard deduction).
- May lower taxes on Social Security and Medicare premiums: A lower AGI can reduce the portion of Social Security that is taxable and may help you avoid higher Medicare Part B and D premiums (known as IRMAA surcharges).

Summary

Giving directly to Calvary Baptist from your IRA through a Qualified Charitable Distribution is a great way to fulfill your giving while reducing your federal income tax liability. If you're over 70 ½ and have an IRA, speak with your financial advisor or tax professional to see how a QCD could fit into your financial plan.
