#### Important Search Team Update

After a couple of months of no visible progress in the search for our next lead pastor, the Search Team met last week Wednesday (11/5) with our lead recruiter from Vanderbloemen to review 4 prospective candidates. Each candidate had already been run through a series of "pre-interviews" with Vanderbloemen and each expressed a deep interest in the role of our Lead Pastor. After the initial presentation, the team committed to reviewing each of the candidates in depth including their introductory videos, resumes and interview notes, communication assessments, and evaluating multiple sermons and services for each one. The Search Team met once again this past Wednesday (11/12) to discuss next steps and each candidate's potential as a prospective lead pastor here at First CRC. Through the course of our prayers and discussion we agreed that two candidates seemed to be potential "good fits" while the other two did not. The team has already initiated contact with the two

selected candidates and is working toward scheduling an initial interview. We are targeting prior to the Thanksgiving holiday but must remain flexible pending everyone's schedules.

We praise God for the opportunity to move in this direction and remain hopeful in our search to find the next Lead Pastor for our congregation. Please continue praying for wisdom and discernment for our team members as well as clarity and a strong calling to be in the heart of the pastor that God has already chosen for us. Please also pray that schedules line up and our interviews may be scheduled without delay.





**NEW!!** Alaska Air One Rescue series by Susan May Warren:

- (1) One Last Shot: Book one in the compelling saga about the heroes who will stop at nothing to bring you home.


