<u>Mission Compromised</u> (A Novel) by Oliver North with Joe Musser: In a first installment of a three-part series, U.S. Marine Major Peter J. Newman discovers that a top military official is planning to betray his country by thwarting a mission to eliminate key Middle East terrorist leaders.

On the Way to the Future: Daniel's Visions and The Believer's Hope by Ray C. Stedman: In "On the Way to the Future", trusted Bible teacher Ray C.
