

**Where is the building?**

Located at 1095 State Street in the midtown neighborhood of Home Park, between Atlantic Station to the north and Georgia Tech's campus to the south. From the Connector, you take the 14th Street exit and head west, and State Street is on the left. MARTA station is Arts Center on West Peachtree Street.

What is the cost of building/property?

\$2 million – Our capital campaign was to raise 10% of the total cost.

How much renovation work needs to be done prior to move-in?

We will update the bathrooms, repaint the sanctuary, finish out several walls on both levels, build a coffee bar, replace building signage (inside and out), property clean-up and landscaping, and install our equipment. Because the building is currently in use every day, it is in really good shape.

Can volunteers help with these projects?

Yes! In fact, we're counting on it.

How much room for growth is there?

More than we've ever had. The sanctuary seats over 200, and there are 10 rooms on the lower level for kids and students. There are also 5 offices/rooms in the administrative suite on the upper level.

What's the parking situation?

There are roughly 40+ spaces in the connected parking lot, and plenty of sidewalk parking on both sides of the property lines. We will publish a suggested parking plan closer to move-in to help communicate all the best options (e.g. if you're *not* dropping off kids, your best bet is on the street so you can just walk right into the main room).

How do we plan to use the building?

In addition to the normal Sunday morning routine, we plan to use the space to house short-term workshops, classes, youth group gatherings, nights of worship, support groups, counseling, and more. We are working with the Home Park HOA to learn of ways we can use the space to serve the neighborhood as well.

When do we move in?

Our plan at this time is to make Easter Sunday (April 21) our last service in the current space, then take two Sundays off in order to renovate, move in, host volunteer training, put on an open house, and move in on Sunday, May 12, 2019.
