## UPDATED INFO

Dear Friends,

Thank you so much for working with us during this time of uncertainty. We have canceled worship services at least through the end of March. We are recording Pastor Aaron's weekly message and posting on our website and Facebook. You are welcome to join us online.

We are committed to doing what we can to make our building available to your group. However, if you feel your group can take a break for a few weeks, please consider doing so. Call Debbie in the office if you choose not to meet. We will note it on our church calendar. If you still want to meet, we ask each participant to make wise decisions about if they need to be here and if so, **always wash with soap and water for 20 seconds** upon entering the building.

When meeting here, please monitor and maintain safe distance from each other. Also monitor the size of the group. If you have more than 10 in your meeting, consider dividing into 2 groups if there is available space in the building. That may be difficult during FFH. The sanctuary is an extra space as is room 110, the nursery across from the office.

**March 22-29:** Faith Family Hospitality (FFH) families will be living here. To maintain separation, we will not be using the south end of the building for any groups. **DO NOT** move your group to the Fellowship Hall or to any room downstairs during that week. **YOU MAY** store your tub in your assigned meeting room that week to eliminate traffic in the south end.

**Reminders:** Sinks are in each of our 6 public bathrooms. There are handwashing sinks in the kitchens and behind the counter in the literature rack area of the church entry and in the coffee making area downstairs. (FFH week use only the sinks in the north end of the building.). We have small bottles of Lite'n Foamy Hand Sanitizer throughout the building. It is an alcohol-free sanitizer which isn't on the recommended list for the coronavirus. The experts recommend a hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.

Available throughout the building are spray bottles of a bleach solution. **PLEASE spray** tables, chairs, doors, and light switches very lightly and let air dry) before and after your meeting/gathering. Look for a bottle in your room or on a counter in one of our public areas. If you want to open windows in your room, please remember to close them before you leave.
