

UPDATE March 19, 2020

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment's Executive Director Jill Ryan, following the White House's lead, issued a public order banning public gatherings of more than 10 people. The order reads as follows:

all mass gatherings shall be limited to:

no more than ten (10) people. Gatherings subject to this Order include, but are not limited to, community, civic, public, leisure, faith-based events, sporting events with spectators, concerts, conventions, fundraisers, parades, fairs, festivals, and any similar event or activity that brings together (10) or more persons in a single room or space at the same time in a venue such as an auditorium, stadium, arena, large conference room, meeting hall, private club, or any other confined indoor or outdoor space.
