



Prayer Guide November 2017

November 1-8: **Openness to Change—Being Flexible**

*"I will teach you the way you should go; I will instruct you and advise you."
Psalm 32:8*

- November 1 Pray for a teachable heart.
- November 2 Ask God if there is anything you need to change.
- November 3 Pray for God to show you how you *have been* open to change.
- November 4 Share with God what changes you fear may come.
- November 5 Open your Bible and read from Proverbs. Delight in the rewards of heeding God's instruction.
- November 6 Pray that your heart will trust God's way is the right way.
- November 7 Pray for the Body of CBC to join together in our openness to change.
- November 8 Pray for the Spirit's clear leading today and through the remainder of 2017.

November 9-15: **Stepping Out—Being Courageous**

"For I am the LORD your God, who takes hold of your right hand and says to you, do not fear, I will help you." Isaiah 41:10

- November 9 Take time today to meditate on the majesty, beauty, and holiness of God.
- November 10 Thank the Lord today for all the ways He has proven His faithfulness to you.
- November 11 Name your fears again and surrender them to God, giving no victory to Satan whatsoever.
- November 12 Investigate the over 80 occurrences of "fear not" found in Scripture, and pray for God's peace.
- November 13 Pray for those you know who are struggling with fear.
- November 14 Pray for clarity and do something "courageous for the kingdom" today.
- November 15 Pray God will lead you to a friend with whom you can be courageous together—and call him or her!

November 16-22 Standing in the Gap—Being Willing

“Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men.” Philippians 2:5-7

- November 16 Stop and consider the actual mind of Christ. Remind yourself of what you already know.
- November 17 Thank God the mind of Christ has been given to you, and deliberately think like Jesus today,
- November 18 Ask God how He desires you to “be Jesus” to others today. Be deliberate and do it!
- November 19 Share with Jesus how you have genuinely sought to serve others and feel His favor.
- November 20 Seek how you can serve on a deeper level. This will require courage again. Be strong!
- November 21 Pray God shows you where the “gaps” are in life and how He desires to use you to fill them.
- November 22 Pray for the love of God’s heart to fill your heart and compel you to “stand in the gap.”

November 23-30 New Horizons—Being “Foolish”

- November 23 The Kingdom of Heaven is now. Pray for God to open your eyes to what you do not see.
- November 24 Pray for your heart to be captivated by His “foolish” love for you.
- November 25 What treasures in life is God asking you to “purchase”? Ask Him what it will cost you.
- November 26 Praise God for being “foolish” in the eyes of man and consider doing the same
- November 27 Pray the enemy doesn’t steal treasures meant for God’s kingdom.
- November 28 List the people in your life who are precious to God but are lost and dead in their sin.
- November 29 Pray that people would become as precious to you as they are to God.
- November 30 Show someone today they are precious to God and you, and risk looking “foolish” for Jesus!
