## WHAT TO EXPECT

An auction is a sale where items are put up for bids, and people can enter into the bidding if they want to buy that item. Upon arrival, each person receives a bidder number so auctioneers can keep track of who buys what. If you win the bid, you will need to show your number so they can write it down. When you leave, your total will be added up and you pay at that time.

You never know what an auction item might go for, especially at CBC! Once in a while you'll get a real bargain, but other times people will bid higher and higher to see how much they can pay for a jar of jelly or pickles, or a beautiful cake.

Many other great items are offered as well like quilts, crafts, paintings, floral arrangements, handmade furniture, theme baskets, and tools. Some things up for bid are for future events like a special meal, a weekend get-away, or a trip to a baseball or football game!
