## Level 2 Descriptions

### **God, Humanity, and Christ**

This course leads you through a systematic theology of God's self-revelation, character and works, as well as who Christ is in his deity and humanity. Work through an introduction to the known, holy and creator God who made us and reveals himself to us in Christ and the Scriptures.

Brought to you by Crosslands, the God, Humanity and Christ course is divided into 8 lessons:

- Lesson 1 – God is Known
- Lesson 2 – God is Holy
- Lesson 3 – God is Triune
- Lesson 4 – God is Creator
- Lesson 5 – God and Humanity
- Lesson 6 – God in Christ
- Lesson 7/8 – Assignment

### **Bible Exposition**
