




Thank You Susan Spivey for 25 Years as Church Pianist

Rev. Gerald Thomas was called to become Associate Pastor. In May 1995, a Historical Marker for our church bell was erected on our campus and the Centennial Celebration began. A display cabinet, in which items would be placed and changed periodically, was placed in the narthex. David Malcom presented the church with a Bible which bore the copyright 1895-1896 and was discovered in an abandoned building by his father. David also located a stained-glass window that came from our 1912 church building, restored it, and today, it hangs in Burch Hall.


