
Dr. Keithen Tucker's Title and Text "Let the Fire Fall" Ecclesiastes 12:13

New lighting, sound, carpeting, enlarged restrooms, relocation of musical instruments, platform expansion, and new decorative furnishings deserve inspection. Installation of faceted glass windows on the exterior walls remain ongoing. Under the capable leadership of Pastor J. 
