Rest. I've been on sabbatical for 30 days and I am grateful to the church and the SPRC for the gift of the first real sabbatical in my life. I am grateful to Beverly and Donnis for the gift of their cabin in Ruidoso, New Mexico (for 10 days) where I was able to begin the sabbatical with a four-day clergy and spouse retreat led by Still Waters Renewal ministry. In God's providential grace, I was on the waiting list to go the retreat (which happened by God's providence to be in Ruidoso) and the day before the sabbatical began, a slot became available for Karen, Jacob and me.

I read several books on prayer and engaged in another pastor's renewal ministry online called Soul-Shepherding - a ministry dedicated to those who shepherd souls. I prayed and meditated upon scripture and ended my sabbatical with a bible prophecy conference named after the last prayer of the bible: "Maranatha." Maranatha means "Come , Lord." I'm looking forward to the Lord's coming again and I want to develop more and more the mindset of eager anticipation that the Messiah will come at any time. Meanwhile, biblical "rest" means to know His presence is with you at all times through the Holy Spirit who lives in you. RESTING in Him is the key to our daily walk.

I was told I needed to rest, but I don't think people understand what rest means. At the end of my sabbatical, my loving wife (we celebrate 45 years of marriage this month—praise God!) told me, "You don't know how to rest." She meant I stayed busy the entire time of sabbatical. There is physical rest, but I didn't need that. There is the kind of rest when you die and they lay you to rest. That's certainly not the kind of rest I was looking for and I'm glad to wait on that rest a little while longer. The word rest in the bible can be found over 500 times. It has various meanings depending on the context. If you ask me "Do you feel rested?" then my response is "I'm resting in Him." Being "busy" and "resting" are not mutually exclusive. Actually, I don't think I can be busy and fruitful in ministry (nor can our great staff) unless I am truly "resting" in the Lord. His yoke is easy. His burden is light. Rest is a mindset. It is having the mind of Christ in all things. I'm working on "resting." I hope all of you are working on resting by meditating upon this truth: "Then Jesus said, "Come to me, all of you who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest." Matthew 11:28 NLT



It will be a time of guided prayer, so there won't just be sitting in silence in a room for an hour. I believe this meeting will also stretch us out of our comfort zone, and that's ok! The ministry of Jesus in our lives is always beckoning us deeper to where it's uncomfortable because it forces us to hold onto him.

I was listening to an interview by Tim Keller before he passed away and the interviewer asked him what he would go back and change in his ministry. He paused and said "I wish I had prayed more." What my hope is for this church is when we look back on this season that we can look back on it and say "I waited patiently for the Lord; he turned to me and heard my cry. He lifted me out of the slimy pit, out of the mud and mire; he set my feet on a rock and gave me a firm place to stand. He put a new song in my mouth, a hymn of praise to our God." (Psalm 40:1-3).

Mission Trip to Peru

After postponing the mission trip due to the dengue epidemic that hit northern Peru, Fany traveled to Peru on June 28th. On the evening of June 29th, she officiated a wedding and celebrated the anniversary of this ministry. God is our provider and this time. He used our brother Jon H., who gave us a special offering that allows us to pay for the tickets and purchase of the theater for the Generacion de Poder ministry. The missionary work is done with those who pray, those who give offerings and those who go to the field. We ask for your prayers so that when Fany opens her mouth, the word of God will be given to her, while He extends his hands so that signs and wonders will be done.

The following is a report from Pastor Fany on her time in Peru:

I am happy to be able to briefly tell you what happened on my missionary trip to Peru.

- 1. I arrived in the city of Lima on June 29, 2023 at 11:00 p.m., leaving for Trujillo at 12 a.m. I arrived at 9:00 am and everything was ready for the 2nd anniversary of the God My Refuge Ministry. I was able to preach in the morning. In the afternoon, the celebration ended with the wedding ceremony of Denise and Jessy. A total of 100 people participated in the anniversary
- 2. Three people were baptized, a married couple and a teenager.
- 3. We traveled with ten people to Yamaluc for three days, where I was able to visit the workplace, preach in the open air, and worship in the town church.
- 4. Mocupe was visited where worship was held at Demetrio's and Teresa's house; their home has become a preaching center. In Mocupe, used clothing was distributed to the residents of the town. Clothing had been donated by the God My Refuge Ministry. I preached in the open air, and five people received Christ.
- 5. A family worship service was held in La Esperanza Trujillo at the house of Jessica's sister-in-law, who is very ill due to diabetes problems.
- 6. A family worship service was held only for couples at the house of Jessica's brother, Genaro.




Adult Ministries




