Greetings to all our friends in the faith and thank you for all your prayers concerning our ministry and family.

March - One of the ministries we have each quarter for the kids in our community is our Hora Feliz. This is a small VBS event that we put on in our central park here in Saladas. This Hora Feliz is our back to school event. At Each Hora Feliz we have songs, a puppet show, Bible lesson, a snack of hot dogs, drinks and a sweet treat for dessert. For this event we put together a water bottle with some school supplies: pencils, erasers, a gospel tract and some candy. To receive a water bottle we hand out wrist bands to each child who is there for the songs, puppet show and Bible lesson. We also have a small gift which includes a packaged cookie and gospel tract for the other kids in the park who usually show up the end when they see us start handing out hot dogs and drinks. We encourage them to come to our next one when we start so they can hear the lesson and receive the special gift. This continues to be a very successful event, and our church people have really got behind it and are a driving force in preparations for and inviting people. One of our newer families started coming to church last year and joined this January because of this event last year. They also invited about 20 of the 48 people we had come this year. We are hoping that from this event we can grow our Sunday School but that also other families will start coming to our church plant as well.



April - Our Easter service went really well this year and we had a good crowd. We started our service with a time of fellowship and a potluck breakfast. Everyone loves this time before the main service of getting to talk, laugh and enjoy fellowshiping with each other over good food and mate or coffee. In our main service, Bro. Martin delivered a wonderful sermon. Agustín was one of our first members to join the church in January of 2025, has been leading our music on Sunday mornings for almost a year now and we are so blessed to have him in this role as our music leader. He did a great job in preparing songs that focused on the resurrection and readying the hearts of the people to receive the sermon God had prepared for them. It was a joyful service! Nothing blesses our hearts more than to see the members of our church plant growing in their faith and maturing in their walk with the Lord.
