



QUESTIONS FOR WEEK SIX

The Mystery of Melchizedek

1. Read Genesis 14:17-20, and Psalm 110:4-5. What picture do you get of Melchizedek from these verses?
2. In your life, how have you seen a parallel between righteousness and peace?
3. The Levites were priests because of their blood line, not their character. What problems could this have caused with their service in the temple?
4. Why do you think Christ set aside the Law (Hebrews 7:18-19)? Did the law stop being necessary?

5. If we are not constrained by the Old Testament law of God in our personal behavior, what are we constrained by?

How does that work in practice?

6. How would you describe the security we have in the fact that Jesus will never die?

7. What are the differences between the Old Covenant that Jesus set aside and this “New Covenant” that He becomes the guarantee for?

8. If we begin living our lives more aware of the reality that we have Christ walking with us every step of the way, speaking to God the Father on our behalf, what might be some of the ways our lives will change?
