BRING

- A Bible (not your phone). - This one's pretty straightforward.
- A Great Attitude. - Come ready to have a good time.
- Clothes for Friday night through Sunday morning.
 - Comfortable Clothes.

 - Pants appropriate for Church Sunday. We'll wear our DNOW Shirts then.

The people of God are to treat all people with dignity and respect, especially those in the family of God. All students should feel welcome, and valued at church. There will be little tolerance for this.
- Do not bring anything for pulling pranks (fireworks, toilet paper, shaving cream, lasers, etc.).
- Inappropriate clothing – No spaghetti straps, short shorts, or mini-dresses on any fellas or lady fellas.

- Honor the rules of your host home.
- You may not leave the DNOW without parental permission AND leader consent.
- Groups may NOT go to other Host Homes.
- All youth must participate in all activities. Anyone too tired or sick to participate will be sent home.
