### Summer Intern

#### 1. PURPOSE

- 1.1 The purpose of the Summer Internship is to assist in carrying out the mission of Potter's House Community Church.
- 1.2 The mission of Potter's House Community Church is to help people be shaped by God to be followers of Jesus Christ.
- 1.3 The Summer Internship provides an excellent opportunity for young people to get experience in ministry and further discover and develop their gifts and talents by being a part of a missional church replant effort.

#### 2. RESPONSIBILITIES

- 2.1 Exact responsibilities of the internship can be built around the applicants' gifts, talents, and passions, so as to maximize their experience and effectiveness.
- 2.2 Engage people in the community with the purpose of building relationships that point to Christ.
- 2.3 Assist the church in activities to engage the community: Kids Camp, Westside Daze Parade Float, etc.
- 2.4 Participate with Worship Team in leading worship (depending on gifts and talents)
- 2.5 Participate in regular ministry to children and youth.
- 2.6 Assist the Pastor and other church staff in the day to day operations of the church.
- 2.7 Assist in working with mission teams that come to help with the ministry of Potter's House.

#### 3. QUALIFICATIONS

- 3.1 Character. The Summer Intern should be a dedicated follower of Christ. In all his or her relationships and finances he/she must demonstrate self-control and integrity.
- 3.2 Knowledge. The Summer Intern must be skilled in the content of the Word of God and in theology.
- 3.3 Teaching. The Summer Intern should be skilled at engaging others with the truth of Scripture both in interpersonal communications and group settings.
- 3.4 Desire. The Summer Intern should desire to see Potter's House grow and thrive. He/ She should see their ministry over the summer as a part of the long-range mission of Potter's House.
- 3.5 Organization. Although the Summer Intern needs to have very good interpersonal skills, it is very important that the Intern can take an assignment and see it through to completion.

#### 4. Compensation/ Arrangements

- 4.1 Compensation and/or living arrangements will be made based on candidate's qualifications, availability, and work status in Canada.
