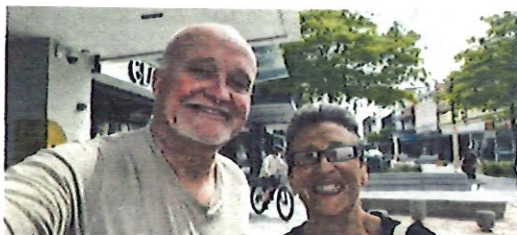
Three Saved! Praise God!

A Unique Opportunity To Reach Out & Witness To The Sikh Community While Visiting Christchurch.

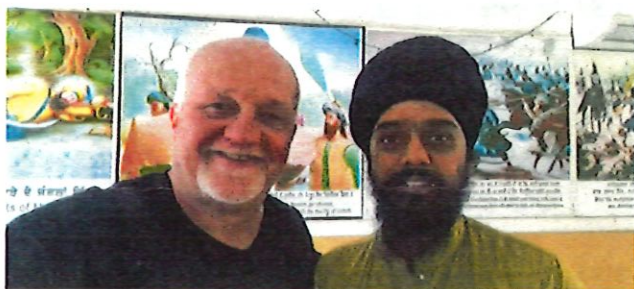

Big Decisions, Big Changes Possibly Afoot In 2026



Proverbs 16:9 – “A man’s heart deviseth his way: but the LORD directeth his steps.”

Melanie and I will be returning to the United States in February 2026 to meet with our sponsoring church, Wises Chapel, to pray, study, council, and determine the Lord’s direction for Melanie and I as missionaries.

We have laboured on our national field of New Zealand for 26yrs as missionaries. Through it all, the Lord has blessed with a multitude of professions of faith for Salvation, and many Baptisms.

We have been involved in at least three major church plants and have ministered in five different Cities and towns across New Zealand, spreading the Gospel.

Tragically, we believe the mission window of opportunity is dwindling dramatically in New Zealand, evident even with the reported disbanding of arguably the most prominent doctrinally MBC in New Zealand, that was planted in Dunedin city; a Work Melanie and I were foundational in planting late in the 1990’s.

It grieves Melanie and I to see the decline, and clear disinterest of ‘Kiwi’s’ (New Zealanders) for the most part who appear evidently disinterested, for the most part, in going any further with Jesus than eternal Salvation it would seem.

This might sound harsh, and I say this as a New Zealander who has loved His nation, that Kiwi’s appear to have become even more significantly spiritually arrogant that they were, and seem to consider the idea of being ‘taught anything’ let alone being ‘Pastored’ almost as an offence and something that is repugnant to them.

Believe me, I have tried for 26yrs and more!

It is a sign of the end times in my view.

2Timothy 4:3-4 – “For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; 4 And they shall turn away *their* ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables.”

Melanie and I wish for God to get the most glory from our lives, to bear as much fruit as we possibly can, being used to our maximum potential in our ministry strengths and giftings to the Glory of God with what’s left of our lives.

We are weary and discouraged with ‘Doing it alone’, and being ‘isolated’ from likeminded Brethren as Missionary Baptist’s in a nation where we seem unwanted, and are for the most part ostracised spiritually, and politically.

As such, we have come to the difficult, and gut wrenching reality that New Zealand may no longer be the mission field for us, and most certainly not if the status quo of ‘going it alone’ on the field was to continue.

‘All options are on the table.’

Now, we are available for whatever field God calls us to.

Options include national mission work out of Wises Chapel in the United States.



We are also open to mission work out of Wises Chapel in another country should a door open.

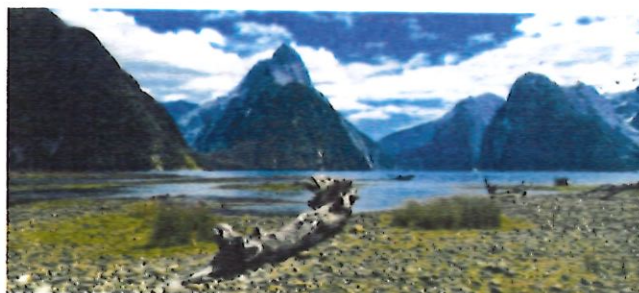
I am open to Pastoring one of the Lord's Assemblies in the United States that needs a Pastor, should God call.
