VISIT TO NEW ZEALAND

The first purpose of visit is to bring revival to a church, to conduct a Bible Conference, and a mission survey. Northshore Bethel MBC in Auckland invited me to conduct a Bible conference. It started when I read a post of a need of a church worker in NZ and I told my son-in-law Aries and daughter Mae, and they responded to the call. But there were some changes so it turned out to be a mission survey as they both have a growing burden for New Zealand. Though Aries was not able to join the trip but we pursued. We arrived in Auckland on January 30, 2026. I preached my first sermon there at Northshore Bethel MBC about “Walking by Faith

as Observed in the Life of Elijah” (1 Kings 17).



In Dunedin, we have given some tracts to people, and hoped to find opportunities of contacts, but the door of opportunity closed. So proceeded to Christchurch, tried to connect with some contacts, friends of friends in fb, and some former or unchurched Missionary Baptists. We found some but they already left the

faith, and one has already become an Orthodox. Praise God we meet the daughter of a fellow missionary in the Philippines. She welcomed us to her home, introduced us to a family who was so accommodating, and so lent their car for our use, treated us with good food, brought us to lake Tekapo, took care of our accommodation, for that night, and the Lord gave us an opportunity to share the gospel to people working there.

From Tekapo, we went to Methven to stay there. While there, I had the opportunity to share the gospel to the partner of our host and he accepted the Lord.



On Saturday we joined the house-to-house visitation evangelism and encountered different reactions to the gospel, but somehow there are those who listened to us.
