August 3, 2025 - after the morning worship at Fellowship in the Word MBC



Preparing the generator for sending to Davao for the missions there, especially for our seminars and evangelistic crusades. It was sent on August 9, 2025. It was received in Davao on August 23, 2025.

August 9, 2025, Saturday
We visited our prospects Bible study, Sister Brenda, who was celebrating her birthday. was also an opportunity share the gospel with their friends and relatives.



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August 11, 2025 - At the airport bound for Davao with Ghie. We also waited for our daughter and her husband to join us on our flight to Davao. However, they were delayed and left behind by the plane. They had a connecting flight from Albay to Manila, followed by another to Davao. Somehow, they boarded another plane and were able to follow us.

Friday, August 15, we traveled to Marilog, more than a 2-hour drive from Davao City. Accompanying me were 3 young men and two workers. When we reached Marilog at the place of Brother Jason, we stayed there for a night and had fellowship and sharing time. That night, it rained, and so we prayed that our way up the mountain would not be so difficult.

August 16, 2025, Since it will take a long time to walk to the chapel up there on the mountain, Brother Jason suggested that I ride a motorcycle to the destination. But there is an area that I have to walk because it is so steep. We need to wrap our bags in plastic so they won't get splashed with mud. It was scary, and sitting at the back was not comfortable, yet I had to be aware and conscious, like I was driving, in case we fell. But there was one time when the motorcycle was going uphill, we fell over into the mud, but I was able to brace myself with my hand.



When we arrived at the place, at the small chapel of the hill tribe brethren, they served us with sweet potatoes. After resting for a while, we started our Bible seminar. Brother John and Brother Mario first gave their lectures. Their topics were salvation, the family of God and the devil, and eternal security. After them, I gave a long lecture explaining further about salvation, baptism, the meaning and beginning, and a brief history of the church. While teaching them, I noticed that they were reading from a Cebuano Bible that had some wrong translations. The translation of baptism is “bunyag”, which means to sprinkle, instead of “bautismo”, and other verses are twisted to mean baptismal regeneration. So I told them not to use such a corrupt version. Since they cannot understand the English Bible, I said, we'd better request a good Cebuano Bible.

August 17, 2025, Sunday -- We started our Sunday School early, about 7:45 am. At about 8 am, I started teaching about Scriptural baptism. But some were unclear about salvation, so I have to go back to the topic of salvation. Then, during the preaching service, I preached about contending for the faith. During the invitation, 10 believers came forward for baptism. After that, I made a special bible study for those

who had some doubts, and when they understood the teaching, they also decided on baptism. So there was a total of 14 baptisms.
