Outreach and Activities



10-2-25, We visited Bethel I MBC at Don Marcelino, Davao Occidental, to see the brethren there.



On our way to Davao City from Davao Occidental, we passed by Digos and met Pastor Sumay at Jollibee. He treated us to dinner. Praise God for the opportunity to connect with old friends. When he was a seminary student, he used to go with me in evangelism and was discipled.



On October 3, 2025, we travelled to Budah, near the borders of Marilog and Bukidnon, Mindanao. We looked for a campsite for a conference. We visited the place of my cousin in Buda, and slept there for a night. There is a Missionary Baptist there at the campsite. We had fellowship with the pastor, and they also prepared food for us. It

was a nice place, good for camping. We had a devotional prayer there. In the morning, we travelled back to Davao and visited some pastors along the way. We passed by a Missionary Baptist church in Marilog and had fellowship with Pastor Arnold Paimalan. After that, we met two more pastors and shared plans for future fellowships.



On October 5, 2025, Sunday, I taught the Sunday School and preached at Gladiola MBC. In the evening, my brother drove us to the airport for our flight to Manila.

On October 10, 2025, Brother Kyle and I went to Las Pinas for Bible study at the Osayan family.

On October 16, we travelled to Albay. I was the speaker for the Thanksgiving anniversary of First Albay MBC on the 19th. It was a long drive. We left about 9:30 am, and arrived in Santo Domingo, Albay at about 10 pm.



October 19, 2025, I preached both in the morning and in the afternoon. There were so many people, including the municipal mayor.



There were many visitors who attended, and some of them I had the opportunity to personally share some doctrines in answer to their questions.



On October 20, Monday, I was invited to pray at the flag ceremony of government officials. After the prayer, I had some time talking with the municipal mayor as he invited me for breakfast. After breakfast, I was allowed to share the gospel with the government employees.



On October 21, 2025, Brother Roland invited me to a campus outreach, and he gathered the students in a high school classroom, and I shared the gospel. About 8 of them professed faith.

On October 23, Thursday, I preached at Tiwi's midweek service. Afterward, we went to conduct a Bible study in a prospect's house in a village. I led the Bible study, and the couple attentively listened.



October 30-31, 2025, I was one of the speakers on the theme, Faithful and Fearless. It is a women's fellowship of churches that we have or had been involved in the ministries in South Luzon, including Cavite, Makati, and Rizal. This was held in Buhi, Bicol region.



On November 1, 2025, I spoke about God's word to these youth during their gathering.



On November 2, Sunday afternoon, we conducted an interrogation, and afterward in the evening, we had a service, and commended to the church, and ordained Brother Aries Balucio to the gospel ministry by the authority of First Albay MBC.

They have already decided to go to the south of New Zealand to do missions, and believe God will provide for their needs. Pray as the three of us will visit New Zealand this January 2026.
