November and December were active months here at WWLMS, most notably marked by the shipment of a 20-foot container to Vanuatu for Bro. Walt Emry.¹ This container was packed with new clothing, Bibles, literature, and personal items, as well as a vehicle that will be a vital resource for Bro. Walt during his several-month ministry on the field. While we initially faced some hurdles with the paperwork, we are grateful to report that the shipment is well on its way, facing only a minor 2-3 day delay in its expected arrival.

Back at the warehouse, we managed a few maintenance challenges that the Lord graciously helped us navigate. We replaced a part on our A/C unit, but because it was still under warranty, we were able to resolve the issue with minimal expense. We also dealt with a puzzling, unusually high water bill for November. After confirming there were no leaks or running water on the property, we decided to turn the water off for a week; upon turning it back on, the next bill returned to its normal amount. While the cause remains a mystery, we are thankful the issue appears to be resolved.

As we move into 2026, the schedule is already filling up. We have successfully shipped two major items this January: a crate to Tanzania² and a 40-foot container to the Philippines³. We are currently in discussions regarding other shipments for the year. Please pray for this ministry and those we serve. Additionally, we have officially launched our 3rd annual Hygiene Kit Drive.
