#### Shiloh Community Center Policies & Procedures

**Weapons:** Firearms, knives, BB guns, air soft guns, slingshots and all other dangerous weapons are strictly prohibited.

**Tobacco & Alcohol:** Smoking, chewing tobacco, and alcohol are prohibited in the SCC or on the Shiloh Community Church grounds.

**Liability:** The user of the SCC will keep and hold Shiloh Community Church harmless from any and all damages, costs and expenses in connection with any and all claims, actions or causes for injury, death or property damage arising from our or of the use and occupancy of the facility.

**Personal Conduct:** All guests are expected to conduct themselves in a mature, responsible manner when using the facility. Abusive language or fighting will not be tolerated and will result in suspension or termination of facility privileges.

**Adult Supervision:** All children 6 years old and younger (including 1<sup>st</sup> grade) must be accompanied by an adult. Second and third grade students may attend activities without an adult but must be signed in and out by an adult. Students 4<sup>th</sup> grade and up may attend activities without an adult but must sign in at the front desk. The SCC staff is not responsible for children/students once they have signed out of the SCC for the day.

**Registration & Liability:** All participants in the SCC Summer Programs must fill out a registration form and a medical liability release form before participating in any activity. Minors must have the form signed by their parent or legal guardian.

**Photography:** It is likely that you or your child will appear in photos or videos by participating in the SCC Summer Programs. These will be used for the restrictive purposes of self-promotion, including promoting the mission and ministries of the church. Please contact the church office to review a full copy of our photo release.
