

TOTALLY EXTREME / CRAFT / WEEK 1

Supplies:

- Pre-cut glitter foam square pieces (assorted colors)
- 2 pieces of linen, each cut into a 6x6 square (2 pieces per child)
- 2 thick pieces of ribbon, each 4 inches in length
- Quick-dry tacky glue
- Black marker
- Scissors
- Ruler

Instruction:

- Preparation (Consider preparing these steps ahead of time):
- Cut Linen Squares: Cut 2 pieces of linen to 6x6 inches each (2 pieces per child).
- Cut Foam Squares: Cut 9 glitter foam square pieces.

Assembly:

- Glue Foam Squares: Glue the 9 foam glitter squares onto the center of the first linen square, arranging them in 3 rows and 3 columns.
- Attach Ribbon to First Square: Take one ribbon and glue the corner to the top left of the first linen square.
- Attach Ribbon to Second Square: Repeat the previous step for the second ribbon, attaching it to the second linen square.
- Attach Ribbon to Bottom: Glue the top of both ribbons to the bottom of the second linen square.
- Final Step: The ephod is now ready to wear!
