

TOTALLY EXTREME / CRAFT / WEEK 3

Supplies:

- Red foam (8x10 square)
- Heart stencil printable page
- Assorted colored beads
- Yarn (2 pieces, 6 inch pieces per child)
- Exacto knife (for adult use)
- Black marker
- Scissors
- Emoji face stickers
- Stick Glue

Instruction:

Preparation (Consider preparing these steps ahead of time for younger groups):

Trace and Cut Heart Shape: Use the heart stencil and a black marker to trace the heart shape onto the red foam. Cut out the heart shape.

Create Yarn Holes: Using the Exacto knife (adult use), create two holes near the top of the heart for the yarn to pass through.

Assembly:

Lay Heart Flat: Place the heart piece flat on a surface.

Decorate the Heart: Cut and glue the quote about David to the center of the heart. Use the emoji face stickers to decorate the heart as desired.

Add Yarn: Push one piece of yarn through one of the holes at the top of the heart. Tie a knot at the end of the yarn to prevent it from slipping back through the hole.

Thread Beads: Choose your desired beads and thread them onto the yarn.

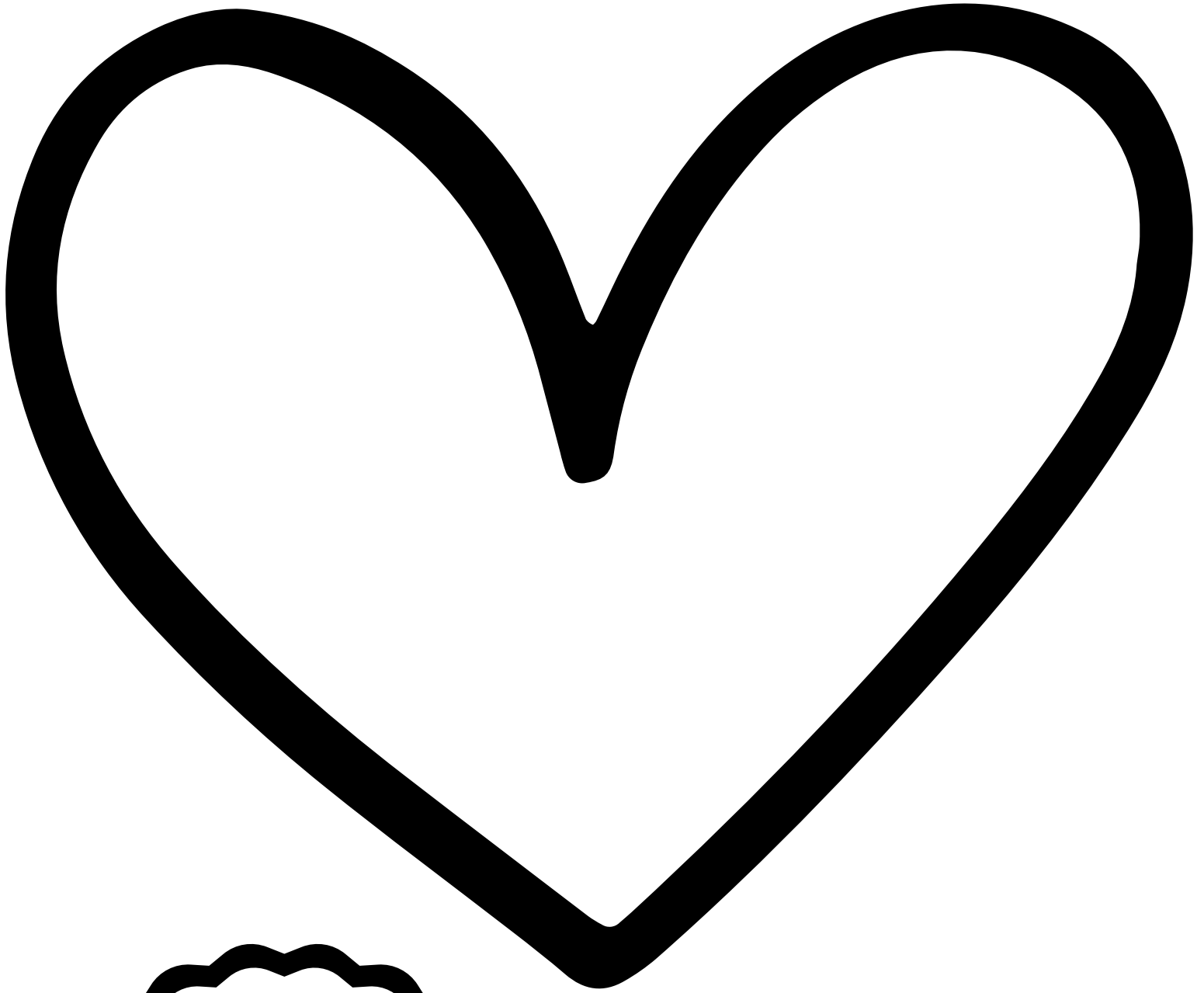
Repeat for Second Piece of Yarn: Repeat the previous steps for the second piece of yarn.

Tie the Necklace: Tie the two pieces of yarn together around the child's neck to create a necklace.

Final Step: Glue a square phrase to the back of the heart.

The heart necklace is now ready to wear!
