ACTIVITY | Jumping For Joy (5 MIN)

PRE SUNDAY PREP: Have

- INSTRUCTIONS:
 - **ORANGE:**For this activity, provide gift sacks like <u>these</u> to use for a sack relay race between two teams.
 - **PURPLE:** Toddlers may not be able to manage a sack race, but they would enjoy adding and removing toys and stuffed animals from the giant gift sacks.
- I'm so excited because it's almost Christmas time, and Christmas brings us so much joy! Christmas carols, colorful cookies, time with friends and family, all the gifts ... I can't wait! But Christmas is still a few weeks away, so we'll have to wait, and while we wait, let's have some fun
- It's never too early to be jumping for joy for Christmas. Let's have a jumping for joy relay race!

PRE SUNDAY PREP: 6 cardboard wreaths in orange room wrapped in contact paper; Have enough pom poms in each room to cover the entire wreaths 3 times; Have 3 cardboard wreaths and paper ornaments cut out about 20 per experience

- **INSTRUCTIONS:** For this activity, obtain <u>cardboard wreaths</u> or make your own by cutting out the middle part of paper plates. Then, wrap the circular frame in contact paper or double-sided tape. Split the kids into teams and give them a large bowl of colorful pom-poms. Line the kids up and have them race to stick pom-poms on their wreaths one at a time. Keep going until each team's wreath is completely covered, or set a three-minute timer. You can also do this more as a collaborative project than a game, giving groups of two or three wreaths to work on together.
- When we see decorations like these and toys wrapped up and sitting under Christmas trees, we know that Christmas is on its way!
- But do you remember why we really celebrate Christmas?
- It's because God promised a savior a long time ago. This savior would connect people back to God. Today's Bible story is all about the time God sent an angel to give this news to a very special young woman.

Story Time

BIG IDEA | Jesus is the savior God promised. (5 MIN)

PRE SUNDAY PREP: Prepare five wrapped boxes in advance, each containing a different toy with a Big Idea tag attached (use one of the <u>Big Idea graphics</u> provided or write your own). Label each box with a number corresponding to the week. If you have a <u>recordable plush</u> available, you could record yourself saying the Big Idea in advance, reset it each week, and gift wrap it in the box again.

- **INSTRUCTIONS:** This week, invite a couple of kids to unwrap box #1. Once unwrapped, say the Big Idea aloud for the kids (or squeeze the tummy if using a recording) and have kids follow along with the motions below.
- What's the Big Idea of today's Joy Story?
 - Jesus is ("Jesus" in ASL)
 - the Savior (<u>"Savior" in ASL</u>)
 - **God** (Point up.)
 - promised (Link pinky fingers together.)

INSTRUCTIONS: Play this week's episode of <u>Cali's World.</u>

- Line Kids up (Lead Teacher in front/assistant in back)
- Exit room to left and walk kids to the kids bathroom
- Allow 4 girls at a time or 4 boys (boys and girls should never go in at the same time)
- Lead teacher stands at the door with foot in door so they can hear if there are any problems
- Assistant helps keeps the kids waiting entertained, quiet and in their spots against the wall
- Make sure to ask if they washed their hands when done
- Once all kids are done and out of the restroom, lead teacher checks to make sure it looks ok, toilets have been flushed and nothing has been placed in toilets.
- Then walk back to class
- We never assist with anything other than buttoning pants and lead teacher should be in view of assistant at all time.
- If a child needs assistance other than buttoning pants the parent/guardian must be contacted

Prayer (5 MIN)

- o Maybe select a different child each week to pray over the snack
 - Give them pointers on praying like how to start..."Dear Jesus" thanking Him for something, praying for anything we might need and then thanking Him for the food.

ACTIVITY | Circle Time (during snack)

- PRE SUNDAY PREP: Print the Bible Story Images <u>here.</u> (they are labeled by episode EX. epslimagel)
 - **INSTRUCTIONS:** Use Bible Story Cards to have kids help you retell the Bible story and answer the following questions
- Who gave God's message to Mary? An angel named Gabriel.
- God promised Mary that she would have a ...? Baby.
- What did God promise the people a long, long time ago? A savior.

- Who is the savior? Jesus!
- Let's say our Big Idea together: Jesus is the savior God promised.

MEMORY VERSE | Luke 1:46-47 (NIV) (5 MIN)

- **INSTRUCTIONS:** Help kids learn this month's memory verse by setting the words (and the Scripture reference) to the tune of "We Wish You A Merry Christmas." You can also have kids repeat the verse after you in small chunks, say them using silly voices, or create simple hand motions for keywords.
- "My soul glorifies the Lord and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior."
