GUIDELINES

DRESS CODE

All students are asked to dress in a respectful and modest way. The following is a helpful guide to define modest; however, Student Discipleship leaders will make the final decision regarding whether clothing is appropriate.

- Shorts: All shorts must be mid-thigh.
- **Shirts:** All shirts must have sleeves. Halter tops, spaghetti straps, or tank tops may be worn with another shirt.
- Mid-Drift: No skin may show between the shirt and pants when arms are fully extended in the air.
- Saggin': No underwear may show.
- Offensive Content: No clothing may be worn with offensive language, sexual innuendo, or drug/alcohol references.
- **Swimsuits:** Girls may wear modest one-piece swimsuits. Guys may wear any shorts-style swimsuit. All students must wear a dark t-shirt in addition to their swimsuit.

Worship Dress Code: Students will not be required to wear long pants or skirts during worship at camp this year; however, students may not wear athletic clothing to evening worship.

CELL PHONES

Cell phones and other communication devices may be used freely during travel, but students may be asked turn in devices upon arrival at camp. Students may freely use their cell phone during afternoon free time. Any violation of the cell phone policy may result in the loss of all cell phone privileges for the remainder of the trip. Students may use their cell phone as an alarm clock or camera.

WHAT WILL WE BE USING FOR TRANSPORTATION?

WHAT ARE THE HOUSING ACCOMMODATIONS?

Housing at Logan Valley Christian Retreat Center consists of twin beds. Students will need to bring their own bedding, such as a sleeping bag or sheets & blankets.

WHAT IS THERE TO DO DURING FREE TIME?

The Logan Valley Christian Retreat Center includes basketball, volleyball, disc golf, water slides, high & low ropes courses, zip line, gym, and a beautiful spring-fed creek for swimming and exploring.

WILL WE NEED MONEY AT CAMP?

Students will not need any money during camp; however; there will be a snack shop to purchase drinks and snacks.

WHAT IS THEOLOGY CAMP?
