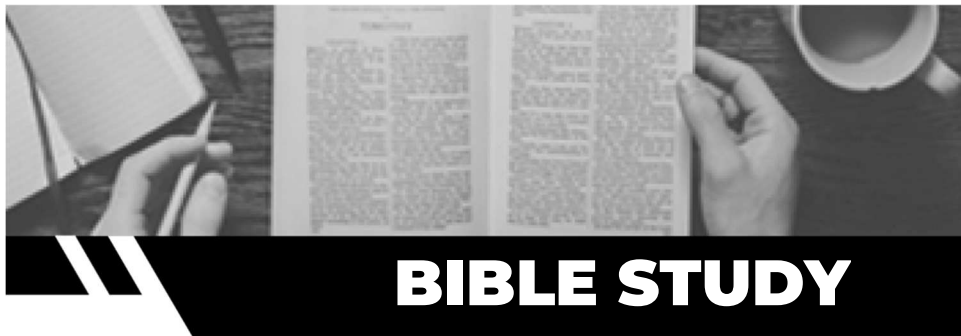




BIBLE STUDY
