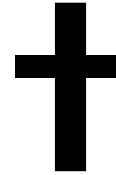

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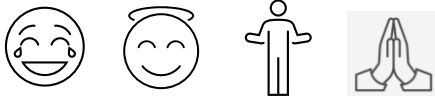
Need to Know – July 5-11, 2026

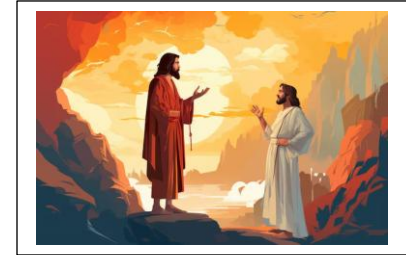
